Directions to the NERR Lebanon Yard- take I-40 East to Exit 238 (US Rt 231), turn left onto US Rt 231 going north. Go about 3 miles or so to Tennessee Av (Ryan's Steak House in the southeastern corner), turn right onto TN Av, go until just before the RR grade X-ing, turn right again onto Knoxville Av (Lebanon Police Bldg on your right), proceed past the NERR shop building to the Music City Star commuter train yard & you're there!
