The Cumberland Division-TCRM Board of Directors have formed a Hobby Shop Committee of 3 BoD members- Terry Bebout, Allen Hicks & Charles Owens- to oversee the operation of the hobby shop. The shop will not be ordering new items for stock except for L&N, TC Ry & a few other roads (maybe NC&StL); however, C Div-TCRM members can still special order new items thru the shop.

The BoD Committee has established a policy that special orders must be paid for within 30 calendar days after the 1st day the shop is open after the member has been notified his-her order is available at the shop. After the 30 calendar day limit ends, the special order items not paid for are subject to being returned to hobby shop stock. Special orders are to be marked with the customer's name and date the 30-day clock starts. A reminder-you must be a current paid-up member to receive the 25% discount off list price. I know getting a membership card is hard - so I do have a list of current members about a month or so old. If you are not on my list... I will take your word you renewed your membership and turn your name over to the Board.

We do have a few things new and the 50% Off Box IS FULL. IF you see something you want maybe we can make a deal to get the stock down...

Nashville Ntrak Report

Nashville Ntrak returned from Louisville, KY late Sunday night after participating in the National N Scale Convention and World's Greatest Hobby on tour show. While in Louisville we were part of a record-setting Ntrak layout that included 701 modules from many Ntrak clubs from around the country and some modules and participants from outside of the United States. Setup for this layout began Wednesday morning at 6:00 am and concluded Friday night at midnight. In between we worked for three very long 18-hr days with many model railroaders that we had never met before. It was truly an amazing experience to meet so many wonderful people with a common interest in railroads and work with them to put together such a huge layout. Here are a few brief statistics: Layout size - 55,000 square feet (1.26 acres) Total number of Ntrak modules - 701 Mainline length in actual feet - 3,810 feet Mainline length in scale miles - 115.5 scale miles Approximate time to run around the layout once - 3 to 4 hours

Upcoming Nashville Ntrak events include the Smyrna Library layout on July 18-20, the Viola Homecoming on August 9, CSX Family Days on August 16, and Thomas the Tank Engine at the TCRM on August 30-31 and September 6-7. We hope to see many of you there!
