At the May 30, 2008 Board of Directors Meeting a policy was adopted for TCRM members obtaining tickets for excursion train rides. In the past some members have paid full price for tickets, some have paid half price for tickets and there were some instances where tickets were not paid for at all. In order to be fair across the board the following policy is in place-

- 1- Volunteer hours worked at TCRM (logged into the book in the admin room) earn one ticket on any trip for every 40 hours
- 2- Members and their immediate family (living with member) 1/2 price tickets on any trip.

Dome car seats are not available for volunteer hours worked or 1/2 price fare.
