Mark & Eddie started on New Years Day. The shop will remain closed until the inventory is completed. Shop managers Mark & Eddie did announce that the inventory reduction sale of 40% off list price for HO & N scale locomotives, rolling stock and structures will continue into January. This sale applies to Cumberland Div-TCRM members only. Every effort will be made to have the shop open next Thursday prior to the Thursday night meeting. However, to do that will require several members' help in completing the inventory.

### Tennessee Central Railway Museum Hobby Shop Sales Policy

- All current TCRM members will receive a 25% discount off the current list price of stock items or 15% above dealer net cost for special discounted items offered by the distributors.
- Members have 30 calendar days to pay for and pick up their special orders after having received notice from TCRM hobby shop staff that the order is available for payment/ pickup. (Continued on other side)

- Members must not remove stock items off of shelves for hold. All stock items are for sale on a first come, first serve basis.
- Special orders do not go into stock if member ordered the wrong item or decided he/she does not want it. Members must pay for their special orders.
- Any item removed for use on Cumberland Divisionowned model railroads must be reported to the clerk on duty before the item is taken from the shop.
- Any member working as hobby shop clerk must be trained on the hobby shop sales computer system.

# **Excursion Train Ticket Policy for TCRM Members**

At the May 30, 2008 Board of Directors Meeting a policy was adopted for TCRM members obtaining tickets for excursion train rides. In the past some members have paid full price for tickets, some have paid half price for tickets and there were some instances where tickets were not paid for at all. In order to be fair across the board the following policy is in place-

- 1- Volunteer hours worked at TCRM (logged into the book in the admin room) earn one ticket on any trip for every 40 hours worked.
- 2- Members and their immediate family (living with member) 1/2 price tickets on any trip.

Dome car seats are not available for volunteer hours worked or 1/2 price fare.
