Two Railroad conventions are coming up that should be of great interest. First is the NRHS 2009 National Convention running August 11-16 at Duluth, MN, "Steam on the Range". The convention will offer a variety of events interpreting the history of the port, the Mesabi Iron Range, and the vital part railroads played in that history. Scheduled are an Inbound Rail Excursion "The Lake Superior Limited" Minneapolis/St.Paul to Duluth and a bus trip to the Half Rust Mine and the Museum of Mining. There will be a night photo session featuring Soo Line locomotives and a second night photo session with DMIR locomotives. There are three other rail excursions and movies of the DMIR from the NRHS archives.

The second convention is the N&W Historical Society 2009 Convention starting July 8, going thru July 12 in Roanoke, VA. Highlights: Virginia Museum of Transportation; O. Winston Link Museum; Lost Railroads of Roanoke Tour; tour of the famous East End Shops; and a ride (including box lunch) on the Roanoke Chapter's N&W caboose #518409. Convention Headquarters is at Hotel Roanoke, built by the N&W in 1882 -renovated in 1994.
