This past January UP RR ran a train from Dallas to Los Angeles that was 18,061 feet long, the longest train ever to traverse UP. The longest in the USA goes to Norfolk & Western with 21,425 feet; 500 cars of coal that ran from Iaeger WV to Portsmouth OH in 1971. However, the longest train ever recorded was a 24,119 foot monster of loaded iron ore in Australia in 2001.
