# Sad News – Passing of 2 NC&StL Ry Icons By Terry Coats

20 Aug 2010 - It is my sad duty to report the loss of two icons from our railroad circles. Last week *Col. James (Jim) Bogle*, author and historian, and maybe the world's greatest authority on the "Great Locomotive Chase" of Civil War fame, died in Georgia. Col. Bogle had been in declining health for over a year. He will be

missed by us the members of the Nashville Chattanooga and St Louis Ry Preservation Society. Col Bogle was laid to rest yesterday in Georgia.

Today, August 20, I received word from family that Broadway Dinner Train engineer, TCRM and NCPS friend *Brownie Spicer* died this afternoon. Brownie was an engineer for the NC&StL Ry for most of his career (Brownie was the pilot for many runs on NC&StL J-3 #576 (the locomotive in Nashville's Centennial Park). Brownie then worked for the L&N; at the startup of the Broadway Dinner Train he was the engineer on that train as well. Brownie was a fine man and loved to talk about his railroading experiences.
