The HO modelers had a very successful run with our HO modular RR at the 2013 TN State Fair. We were in the north end of the Exhibitors Building. The RR ran well, no major mechanical or electrical problems (some memorable wrecks when one train ran into the rear of the train ahead). TCRM member Mike Irwin had his 8' of straight modules depicting a British village with a station and a goods shed and a signal box. Overall, the RR was 8' shorter in total distance than the 2012 setup. The configuration starting from the northwest corner and going clockwise-
