Nashville Traction Researcher Needed By Don LeCroy

As I related in our phone conversation this morning (30 Oct 2013), I had volunteered to act as local researcher to locate as many vintage photographic images as possible for a new book by Mr. David Steinberg, who has published at least four volumes on Chattanooga streetcars and railroad stations so far. He has amassed a considerable amount of obscure historical data relative to Nashville's transit heritage, but needs about 90-100 more photos to make-up the required content for the publisher, Arcadia. The target date of approximately March 2014 allows plenty of time for continuing the efforts I have already started, were it not for my recent diagnosis of cancer which will unavoidably sideline me, and since David is in New York and cannot commute back and forth for this work, my situation will cause a valuable tome not to reach market, and Nashville will remain unknown in its traction contribution.

It occurred to me that this facet of rail history would be a great project for TCRM as it would without doubt increase its contribution to historic preservation and spread its reputation wide and far as the book would be distributed through major vendors such as Barnes and Noble, Amazon etc., and would likely be sold widely in the subject area, Middle Tennessee.

I would hope that someone, particularly if they have an interest in the fascinating history of traction in Nashville, Murfreesboro, Columbia and Clarksville, might volunteer to contribute a little time following-up on the tremendous work Mr. Steinberg has already done and the effort I have started to bring this forgotten chapter to light as it so deserves.
