TCRM & NMRA member **Patrick Slota** is continuing his more-compatible-with-DCC rewiring of the 36' yard. He's removed all the old wiring and replacing with DCC track power buss wiring plus a 12 VDC power buss wiring to run the Tortoise switch motors. This means the RR will not be operational for several days. His goal is to have it back operational by March 5.

We have procured 3 pieces of TC Ry-lettered freight rolling stock from the **Don Gage** estate- these are Cumberland Div limited run car kits, 2 Red Caboose TC RY 79xx series box cars & 1 Athearn 2-bay offset-side open hopper.
