# Corporate Changes – Cumberland Division SER-NMRA & TCRM

About a year to 18 months ago, I received a phone call from the then-president of SouthEastern Region (SER) of the Nat'l Model RR Assoc (NMRA), Alan Mole. What prompted the call was increased interest-concern amongst SER leadership (and NMRA national leadership) regarding the legal & business relationship between Cumberland Division SER-NMRA and TCRM. Essentially the concern was primarily the potential liability for NMRA, SER & Cumberland Division for the TCRM excursion train operation. The main end result from a series of phone calls, E-mails, in-person discussions, etc is that the TN domestic non-profit corporation Tennessee Central Railway Museum & Model Railroad Club has been officially dissolved. Then the TN domestic non-profit corporation Cumberland Division SER-NMRA (the IRS 501(c)(3) federal income taxexempt entity) name was officially changed to Tennessee Central Railway Museum & Model Railroad Club. The IRS has officially acknowledged the name change. The appropriate paperwork has been filed with the Davidson Co Register of Deeds. Yet to be accomplished is to get the TN Dept of Revenue to issue a Certificate of Sales Tax Exemption with the current corporate name for TCRM.

The net effect of all this legal & bureaucratic hoop-jumping and sticky wicket negotiating is to remove Cumberland Division SER-NMRA from any liability for TCRM operations & any liability arising from owning real or personal property.

#### **TCRM Gets A Utility Cart**

On Dec 10 TCRM took delivery of a Cushman 1200X EFI utility cart. This cart is for TCRM grounds maintenance, excursion train maintenance, parking crew use, etc. It is NOT for ferrying passengers or TCRM visitors around the Museum, up & down the platform or to & from motor vehicles. The cart's home is in the east end of the electric jack house, seen in the left side of the photo below. There is also a log sheet on a clipboard hanging on a wall of the electric jack house. Cart users are to log their use of the cart on the sheet. An effective writing instrument accompanies the clipboard.

The cart's bed is a tilting one, so we can use it to haul & dump material like rock, gravel, hay bales, tie plates, etc. We will also have a non-alcohol gasoline container so marked for refueling the gas tank (passenger side, seats tilt forward to get to the tank); fuel fill outlet is above & slightly right of the right rear wheel.
